

City Council Regular Meeting
May 1, 2023

A City Council regular meeting was held on the above date at Cameron City Hall, McLane Municipal Center, 100 South Houston Avenue, 3rd Floor, Cameron, Texas with all officers and members present except Council Member Hardeman and City Secretary Amy Harris

Mayor Harris called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Council Member Fuchs offered the invocation.

Council Member Pratt led the pledge of allegiance.

Mayor Harris asked for citizen's comments.

Texas Game Wardens will host Kid Fish Day on May 20, 2023 at Ledbetter Park from 9 a.m. to Noon.

City Manager Ricky Tow clarified total expenditures regarding the clean-up for freeze. Amount spent as of May 1, 2023 is \$80,728.59.

Brad Horn, pilot at the airport reported disruption of traffic by non-pilot, helicopter activity at the airport and credit card charge error at the fuel pump.

There were no other citizens comments.

Council Member Deal moved to approve the April 17, 2023 as presented. Council Member Cryer seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Cameron Economic Development Director presented bids for the EDA Grant – Adams Street Project. No action is requested at this time.

Council Member Deal moved to table the item until the next meeting. Council Member Goza seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Fuchs moved to table the water line project for West 8th Street to separate and re-bid bore jobs. Council Member Pratt seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Fuchs moved to approve the expenditures for April 15, 2023 through April 28, 2023. Council Member Goza seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

The following expenditures exceeded \$25,000.00:

- CEDC \$ 29,790.56
- Freese & Nichols Inc \$258,322.50
