

City Council Regular Meeting
July 3, 2023

A City Council regular meeting was held on the above date at Cameron City Hall, McLane Municipal Center, 100 South Houston Avenue, 3rd Floor, Cameron, Texas with all officers and members present except Council Member Deal.

Mayor Harris called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Stephen Fuchs offered the invocation.

Council Member Goza led the pledge of allegiance.

Mayor Harris asked for citizen's comments.

There were no citizens comments.

Council Member Fuchs moved to approve the minutes of the June 19, 2023 regular meeting. Council Member Pratt seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

City Manager Ricky Tow presented the CPI increase for solid waste pricing. There will be no increase needed for the residents since the fuel surcharge has dropped slightly.

Stephen Fuchs and Neal Bhakta representing the Cameron Lions Club proposed a continued partnership to improve the City Park and consider re-naming the park.

Council Member Fuchs moved to approve the creation of a resolution renaming the park to Lions Centennial Park. Council Member Goza seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Scott & Cody Schoppe requeste permission to use the Cameron Airpark for the 5th Annual Project Maynardstang Cruise-In event on Saturday, September 30, 2023 from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m.

Council Member Goza moved to approve the request as presented. Council Member Dominguez seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Fuchs moved to table and have Eddie Westbrook re-apply agenda request for Cameron Hood Day since no one was present. Council Member Goza seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Fuchs moved to approve the expenditures for June 17, 2023 through June 30, 2023. Council Member Pratt seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
