

City Council Regular Meeting
May 5, 2025

A City Council regular meeting was held on the above date at Cameron City Hall, McLane Municipal Center, 100 South Houston Avenue, 3rd Floor, Cameron, Texas with all officers and members present.

Mayor Fuchs called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Council Member Deal offered the invocation.

Council Member Pratt led the pledge of allegiance.

Council Member Deal moved to approve the expenditures for April 18, 2025, through May 2, 2025. Council Member Cryer seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.
