

City Council Regular Meeting  
November 17, 2025

A City Council regular meeting was held on the above date at Cameron City Hall, McLane Municipal Center, 100 South Houston Avenue, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Cameron, Texas with all officers and members present except Council Members Pratt and Dominguez

Mayor Fuchs called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Council Member Deal offered the invocation.

Council Member Harris led the pledge of allegiance.

Mayor Fuchs asked for citizen's comments.

There were no citizens' comments.

Council Member Deal moved to approve November 3, 2025, regular meeting minutes. Council Member Harris seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

Major Gamble and Mr. Stubbs presented Street Supervisor Craig Arnold with an appreciation plaque and gift card to the Parks Department.

Major Gamble and Mr. Stubbs presented Mayor Fuchs with an appreciation plaque, \$1,000 donation and twenty \$50 gift cards to Brookshire Brothers for needy families in the area.

Police Chief Carlton Scott and Officer Justin Anastasiades updated the Council on the three outstanding grant applications:

- Axon Camera grant through Governor's office has funded.
- Rifle Resistance Vest is \$20,000 federal grant. The City of Cameron will purchase 11 vests and will spend \$659 out-of-pocket
- Awaiting answer on \$21,474 federal grant for rifle resistant windshields.

Council Member Deal moved to approve the expenditures for October 25, 2025, through November 7, 2025. Council Member Vaculin seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.
