

City Council Regular Meeting
April 20, 2026

A City Council regular meeting was held on the above date at Cameron City Hall, McLane Municipal Center, 100 South Houston Avenue, 3rd Floor, Cameron, Texas with all officers and members present except City Secretary Amy Harris.

Mayor Fuchs called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Council Member Deal offered the invocation.

Mayor Fuchs led the pledge of allegiance.

Mayor Fuchs asked for citizen's comments.

Hill Culpepper spoke about deposit on open records request as well as concerns about Police Department harassing certain small businesses. Mr. Culpepper also questioned involvement of ICE.

There were no other citizens' comments.

Council Member Deal moved to approve April 6, 2026, regular meeting minutes. Council Member Dominguez seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Deal moved to deny the street project bid, and Council Member Pratt seconded the motion. Following discussion, the Council expressed agreement that improved streets are needed and emphasized the importance of ensuring high-quality materials and proper workmanship. Mayor Fuchs then directed Street Supervisor Craig Arnold to compile and present all associated costs—including labor, materials, and procedures—at the next meeting. The motion carried, with Council Member Dominguez voting in opposition.

Council Member Harris moved to approve the expenditures for March 27, 2026, through April 10, 2026. Council Member Deal seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

The following expenditure exceeded \$25,000.00:

- Waste Connections \$43,616.69
- TMRS \$31,264.28

There being no other business to consider, Council Member Deal moved to adjourn the meeting. Council Member Pratt seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.
