

City Council Regular Meeting
July 6, 2026

A City Council regular meeting was held on the above date at Cameron City Hall, McLane Municipal Center, 100 South Houston Avenue, 3rd Floor, Cameron, Texas with all officers and members present except City Secretary Amy Harris and Council Members Sims and Vaculin.

Mayor Fuchs called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Council Member Deal offered the invocation.

Mayor Fuchs led the pledge of allegiance.

Mayor Fuchs asked for citizen's comments.

There were no citizens' comments.

Council Member Harris moved to approve June 1, 2026, regular meeting minutes. Council Member Dominguez seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Deal moved to approve a resolution by the City of Cameron of the State of Texas requesting financial assistance from the Texas Water Development Board; Authorizing Filing of an application for assistance; and making certain findings in connection therewith. Council Member Cryer seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Deal moved to approve a letter agreement between Matthew H. Humble and The City of Cameron regarding three tracts of land. Council Member Harris seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Harris moved to approve the expenditures for May 23, 2026, through June 26, 2026. Council Member Harris seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.
