

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-09-08-016**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMERON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION TO THE EDA FOR PUBLIC WORKS AND ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION OF THE CARES ACT**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Cameron desires to apply for funds through EDA Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Programs including Cares Act Funding for investment for public works and Economic Development Facilities;

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary and in the best interests of the City of Cameron to apply for funds for Public Works and Economic Development Facilities;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CAMERON, TEXAS:**

1. That the City of Cameron apply for funds through EDA Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Programs including Cares Act Funding.
2. That the City of Cameron request the maximum amount of funds available through the EDA Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Programs including Cares Act Funding.
3. That the City of Cameron authorizes an in-kind match of \$5,040.36 equivalent to labor for Zipping, and Chip sealing; \$14,460.00 In-Kind for Material Hauling and \$13,757.07 in cash from the FY 2020 -2021 Streets Department budget for chip sealing Industrial Boulevard, Blake Avenue and 2420' of Old Waco Highway.
4. That the City of Cameron acknowledges and accepts match contribution from the Cameron Economic Development Corporation of \$63,028.55 in cash and \$43,491.50 In-kind match for ROW acquisition for the Adams Avenue safety improvements.
5. That the application for the EDA Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Programs including Cares Act Funding is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City and any other appropriate agencies as defined in the regulations.
6. That the City Council directs and designates the Mayor as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application.

7. That all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local and program requirements.
